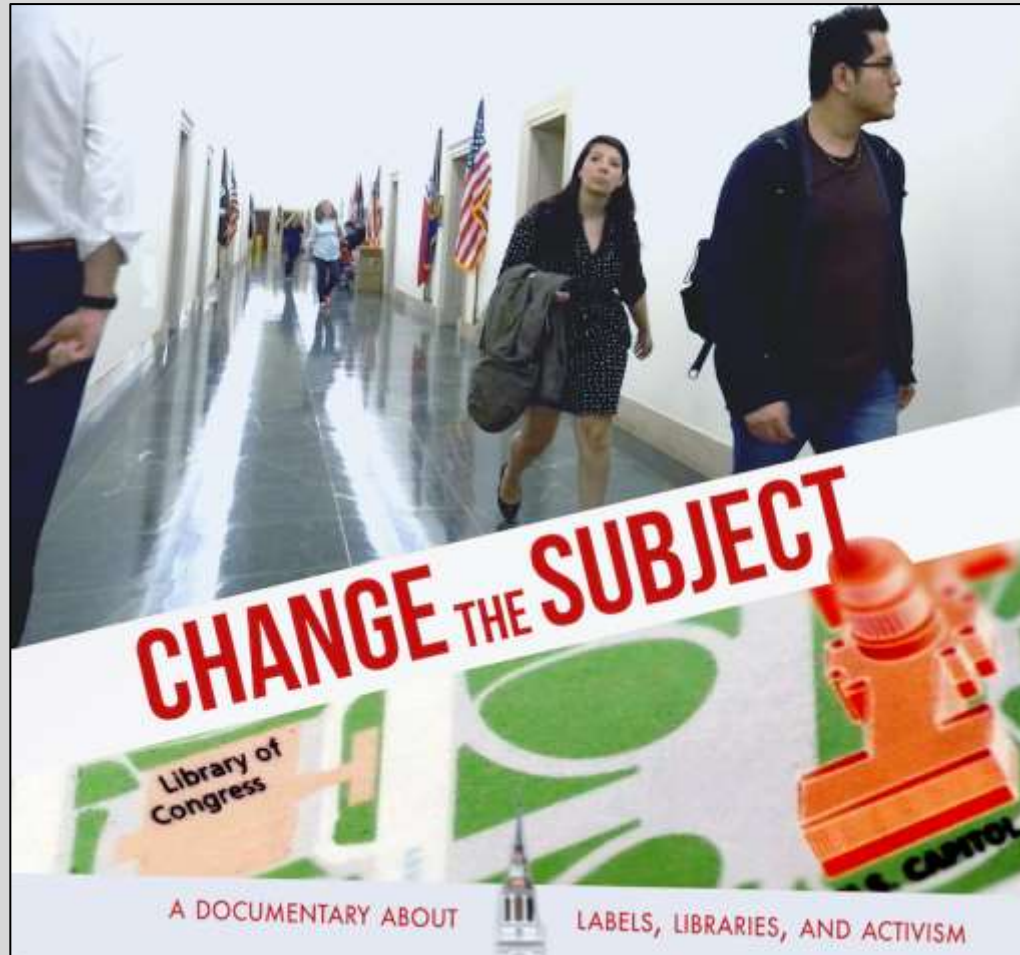

WASHINGTON, D.C.—The American Library Association (ALA) praised the Library of Congress's decision to update the cataloging subject headings "Aliens" and "Illegal aliens." The Policy and Standards Division of the Library of Congress, which maintains Library of Congress Subject Headings, announced the decision to replace the terms with new subject headings "Noncitizens" and "Illegal immigration" at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 12.

# Enhancing Records

- Retrospectively applying new Library of Congress Subject Headings: <https://classweb.org/approved-subjects/>

- Our process:

- Search heading in OCLC WorldCat
  - Search subject heading and titles (650 & 245 fields)

Heading	Possible Search	Explanation
<b>Racism in criminal justice administration</b>	Su: Racism in criminal justice administration and li:ERE	Keyword searching words in the subject headings and limiting to our holdings

- Analyze record found
  - Review titles, content notes, and current subject headings (245, 505, 520, and 650 fields)
- Add heading
  - Update WorldCat and local catalog record



# Enhancing Records: contd.

- Challenges

- Scope of subject heading

- Attempt different combinations
    - Try outdated terminology
    - Leave out articles or prepositions
    - Watch out for punctuation
      - Example: Racism against indigenous peoples

- PCC records (042 field)

- Other exceptions

- Cooperative catalogs

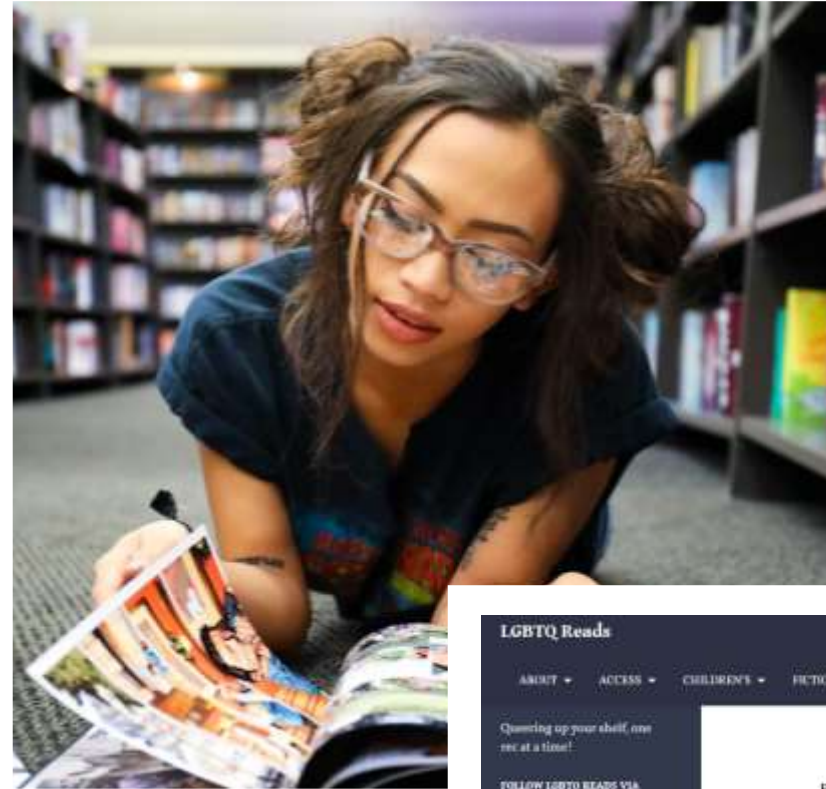

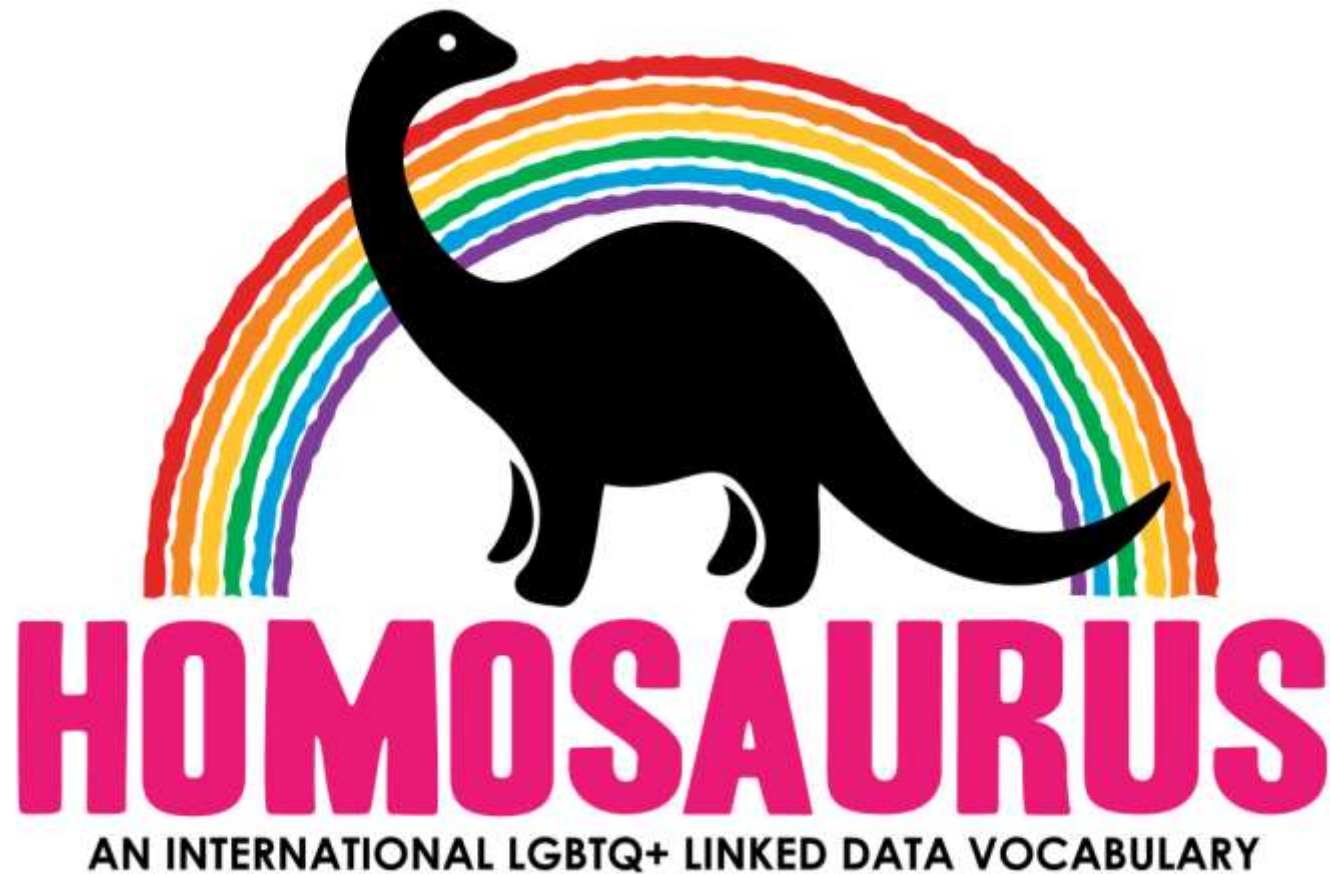

Libraries, archives, museums, and other institutions are encouraged to use the Homosaurus to support LGBTQ research by enhancing the discoverability of their LGBTQ resources.”
