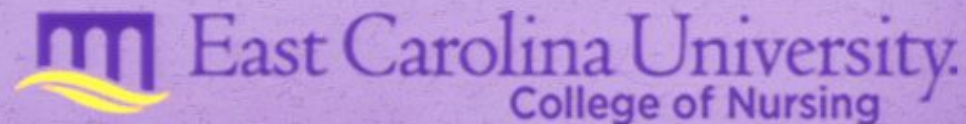

  - Focus: Health promotion/disease prevention





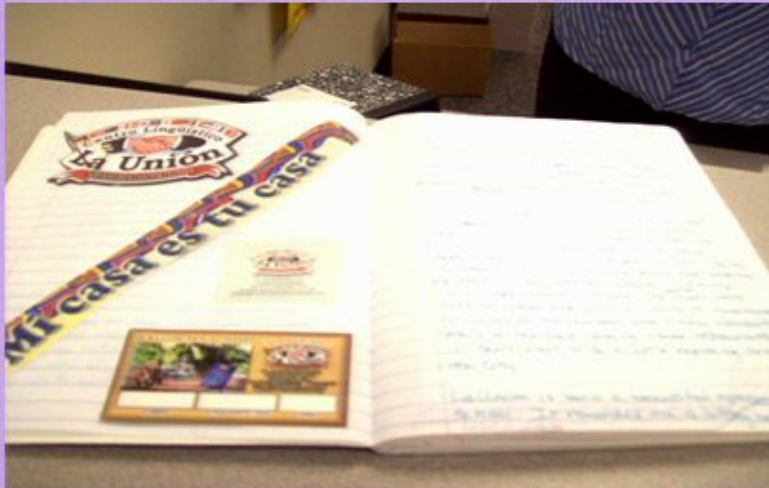

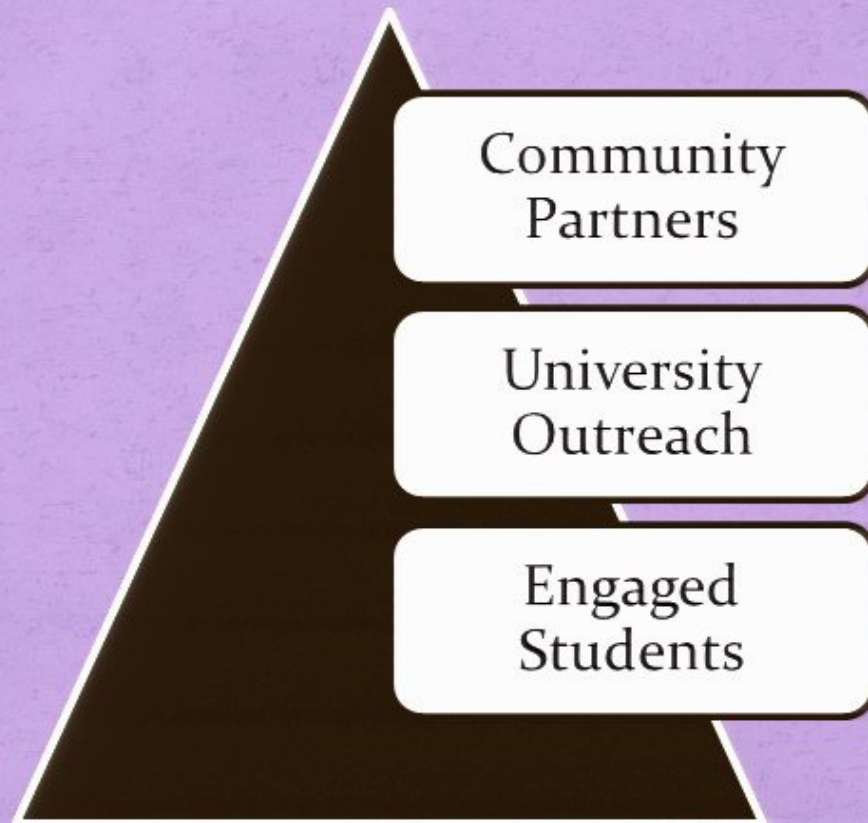
